Turner Dairy Farms Honored at World Dairy Expo for Fifth Time
Turner's White Milk, 2nd Place; Chocolate Milk, 3rd Place; and Cottage Cheese, 2nd Place, win awards at largest comprehensive dairy judging competition in the nation

(PITTSBURGH, PA) September 4, 2009 – What is becoming an annual occurrence, Turner Dairy Farms placed at the World Dairy Expo's Championship Dairy Products Competition for the fifth time. This year, Turner's 2% White Milk, narrowly edged by one-tenth of a point, and Low fat Cottage Cheese took home 2nd Place accolades, and their 1% Low fat Chocolate Milk won 3rd Place.

The competition, sponsored by the Wisconsin Dairy Products Association, is held in conjunction with the World Dairy Expo in Madison, Wisconsin. The competition holds the distinction of being the only comprehensive dairy judging contest in the nation. Entries were received from dairies across the US.

“We work hard to produce the highest quality, freshest dairy products available,” explains Chuck Turner, Jr., third generation President of his family's dairy business, “Placing at the World Dairy Expo for the fifth time in six years speaks volumes to the hard work our family farms and employees put into our products.”
